#### **GETTING THERE:**

- 1] <u>Driving</u>: the hotel is situated 3 blocks south of 16th Avenue North (Trans-Canada Highway) -- use 36th Street NE exit.
- 2] <u>LRT</u>: Marlborough Station is about a 15-20 minute walk from the hotel. Current adult fare is \$2.50 one-way.
- 3] <u>Flying</u>: the hotel provides complimentary shuttle service (use the free phone at Bay #10 of the airport).

#### PRIZES

#### **COMMUTER FEE:**

- 3] Players are expected to provide all necessary game equipment (board, tiles, clock, racks, scoresheets, pens etc.)

Local players who show up without equipment will be surcharged \$10, and players who find themselves paired without equipment will both be given 50-point forfeit losses if they are unable to secure equipment in time to play their game.

- 4] All players <u>must</u> be current members of the North American Scrabble\* Players Association (*www.scrabbleplayers.org/w/Membership*).
- 5] All three events will be subject to Gibsonization rules wherever necessary.
