Other Details

LOCATION: Our tournament site is the Banquet Room of The Sierras of Heritage, 8535 Bonaventure Drive SE, Calgary, AB, Canada Getting There:

- 1] *Driving*: from the intersection of Heritage Drive & Macleod Trail, either go:
 - South to 86th Ave., left (east) to Bonaventure Drive, & left (north) again the Sierras are on your left, or
- East on Heritage Drive, right (south) on Bonaventure Drive. The Sierras are on your right.
- 2] *LRT*: Heritage Station is situated just west and south of Heritage & Macleod, about a 10-15 minute walk to/from The Sierras. One-way tickets are currently \$3.25

ACCOMMODATION:

- The Econo Lodge (7505 Macleod Trail south) is about a 5-minute cab-ride from the venue. For current rates, call 1-403-252-4401
- The Carriage House is about a 10-minute walk, situated at 9030 Macleod Trail south. For current rates, call 1-403-253-1101 TOURNAMENT:
 - 1] Players MUST arrive by 8:30 to facilitate pairings, help set up and keep us on schedule.
 - 2] Players are expected to provide all necessary game equipment (board, tiles, clock, racks, scoresheets, pens etc.)
 Local players who show up without equipment will be surcharged \$10, and players who find themselves paired without equipment will both be given 50-point forfeit losses if they are unable to secure equipment in time to play their game.
 - 3] All players MUST be current members of NASPA. If your membership is about to expire (or has), you can renew on-line (www.scrabbleplayers.org/w/Membership).
 - 4] All players are expected to have read the official tournament rules and be aware of recent updates.
 - 5] A division leader will be gibsonized according to current practice (i.e. 1-game & 1,000-pt spread/game remaining).
 - 6] Directors reserve the right to adjust Division sizes & Pairings Systems in the best interest of the tournament. Such changes will be announced before play begins.
